This programme offers an informal and engaging style of learning to give young people the opportunity to:

- develop their own personal growth and engagement in, and through, learning
- engage in learning that is relevant to them and support their development of personal skills and attributes that are essential for working life and employment
- prepare themselves for progression into further education programmes, apprenticeships or other work based learning

The Level 2 Certificate is equivalent to 2 'B' grades at GCSE.



What will it be like?

The qualification is **portfolio based** with **NO final exam**. Dates for final submission of portfolio work will be given up to a month before internal moderation takes place.

We choose 6/7 modules to study out of the following:

- Career planning
- Digital skills
- Experiencing the world of work
- Managing money
- Preparing for the world of work
- Project based learning
- Presentation skills
- Teamwork skills
- Wellbeing

Assessment

There are no external examinations in this course. Pupils will be awarded the qualification based on portfolio evidence. There will be 6/7 portfolios in total. It is important that portfolios are fully completed to moderation standard for pupils to pass these qualifications. **This is a pass or fail subject only.**

Career Progression
