What will I learn?

The course consists of three mandatory units worth 40 credits:

- Government, Policies and the Public Services
- Leadership and Teamwork in the Public Services
- Citizenship, Diversity and the Public Services

You must also study, from a pool of 18 optional units, a range of modules to a maximum of 20 credits, in order to secure your qualification. Optional units are extremely varied. Examples include:

- Crime and its effect on society
- Command and control in the uniformed public services
- Police powers in the public services
- Outdoor and adventurous expeditions
- Enhancing public service delivery through the use of ICT
- Physical preparation, health and lifestyle for the public services
- Understand the impact of war, conflict and terrorism on public services

Optional units studied will be at the discretion of the teacher(s) delivering the course and reflect their particular expertise.
